The National Conference of Jewish Social Service will meet this year in Denver, Colorado. The meetings will begin with the various committee sessions on the afternoon of June 7th and will continue through June 10th.

A Denver Committee has already been appointed and is at work on the question of housing members of the Conference during their stay and providing us with facilities for adequately and efficiently conducting our meetings and also with respect, in so far as possible, to being helpful in the matter of recreation and hospitality.

The attention of both the professional workers and trustees is called to the fact that it is hoped that at least one day's session will be held at Colorado Springs which is very close to Denver. It is hoped that many persons will be induced to come to this Conference by virtue of the fact that they will have the additional opportunity of enjoying their summer vacations at Estes Park or Yellowstone Park or any of the other places that afford rich opportunity for rest and recreation and that are more easily accessible when one is in Denver.

The Northwestern Railroad and the Union Pacific Railroad are anxious to arrange for a special conference train to leave Chicago at 11:30 on the night of June 5th and arrive in Denver on the morning of June 7th. It is hoped that when you receive railroad notices in respect to this matter you will make early reservations so that as many as possible will be accommodated on the special train.
